Safety

- Do not overestimate your own abilities and keep your speed down.
- Check out your MTB before leaving and make sure you carry sufficient water, snacks and a repair kit with you.
- If you go out alone, tell your friends or family where you are heading.
- Make sure your insurance policy and health certificates are up to date.
- We recommend you wear a helmet and brightly-coloured clothes (in order to be visible)
- In the hunting season: contact the Hunting Federation (+33 475878820) for the dates of official group hunts organized by the local authorities.

Viviers, the former capital of Vivarais, is a very "remarkable heritage site" (« Site patrimonial remarquable »). Some 2000 years of history have left their mark on the town, from Roman times right up to the present day: the Roman bridge, the old Bishop's Palace, the « Maison des Chevaliers » / House of Knights and Saint Vincent's cathedral. Here, stones are the silent witnesses of a rich past.



The Via Rhôna green trail



What if the best way to enjoy the Rhône was at your pedals? To gain access to its banks or observe the natural environment, simply climb on your bike or don your running shoes to explore the ViaRhôna. This green trail crosses our area for 16 kms between Viviers and Bourg Saint Andéol. The Robinet bridge (listed monument), the dead reaches (called « lônes »), the old towpath are just some of the things you will discover along your way!

The Rhône Gorge

The cliff-lined Rhône gorge just north of Donzère can be seen from afar. In geography books, it used to mark the transition from the Mediterranean to the semi-continental region. The natural environment here benefits from special measures to protect the Eurasian Eagle Owl.
